Title	Seasonal Maintenance Staff
Job Summary	These employees will be involved in all facets of the daily maintenance operations including, but not limited to: equipment operation and maintenance, turf cultural practices, irrigation maintenance, daily field preparation and facilities maintenance. Employees must also be able to interact with the patrons and carry themselves in a proper public manner.
Supervision	The Seasonal Maintenance Staff will report to the supervisors. After training, all staff will be expected to complete their daily tasks in accordance to the training manual.
Task Description	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Equipment Operation/Maintenance<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Operation of equipment in a safe and appropriate manner to help maintain all facilities that Sylvania Recreation is responsible to maintain.b. Operate all equipment in a manner for which it was designed.c. Report all equipment problems to the supervisors and follow the proper tag-out procedure.d. Report any safety hazards to the supervisors immediately.2. Turfgrass Cultural Practices<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Maintenance of the turf areas, which includes mowing, weed whipping and pulling weeds.b. Proper equipment operation to ensure minimal damage to the turf areas.c. Report any safety hazards to the supervisors immediately.3. Field Preparation<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. All fields are prepared for game as described in the training manual.b. Report any safety hazards to the supervisors immediately.4. Facility Maintenance<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Follow procedures as stated in the Sylvania Recreation Maintenance Standards.b. Report any safety hazards to the supervisors immediately.5. Communication, Professionalism, & Pride<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Communicate with the supervisors and seasonal staff in a professional manner.b. Take a sense of pride in the job's you perform.c. Communicate effectively with the patrons of the facilityd. Develop a team spirit throughout the entire workings of the department.6. Perform related duties as assigned or as the situation dictates.
Compensation	Maximum of 40 hours per week depending on the season, with possible over-time. Wage rate may vary from \$7.30-\$9.25 per hour based on experience. Wage increases are influenced by overall performance. Must be able to work on weekends, evenings and holidays.
