Support & Sportsmanship

- Encourage respectful behavior and emphasize effort and learning over winning.
- Model good sportsmanship toward coaches, officials, players, and other spectators.
- Respect officials' decisions and refrain from coaching from the sidelines.

Communication

- Address concerns calmly and through proper communication channels.
- Allow appropriate time before discussing game-related concerns with coaches.
- Avoid negative comments, confrontations, or inappropriate language at events.

Responsibility

- Ensure your child arrives on time, prepared, and ready to participate.
- Reinforce teamwork, respect, and accountability.
- Remain in designated spectator areas during practices and games.
- Follow all facility rules and staff directions.

Prohibited Behavior

- Verbal or physical abuse.
- Harassment, intimidation, or bullying.
- Disruptive behavior during practices, games, or events

Accountability

Failure to follow this Code of Conduct may result in:

- Warning
- Removal from a game or event
- Suspension from future activities
- Removal of a child from the program in severe or repeated situations
